
THE WITTENBERG SUMMER SCHOOL

Participants

The organizers encourage students from all disciplines, especially American Studies, Cultural Studies and the Social Sciences, from all German Universities to apply to the Summer School. Students from neighboring European countries will be selected through a special application process in coordination with local U.S. Embassies and other partners. The conference language will be exclusively English. Attendance will be limited to 30 participants.
